Curriculum Information

At Yas American Academy we offer a US Common Core, Massachusetts State Curriculum, which is the most highly regarded in the United States. The state of Massachusetts has long established links with prestigious higher education institutions such as Harvard University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). Consequently, our curriculum places strong emphasis on science, technology and literacy across all subjects.

There is also heavy emphasis on co-curricular pursuits that also foster well rounded students. The Massachusetts Curriculum at Yas American Academy is clearly structured, challenging and effectively delivered by our wonderful team.

Students in the state Massachusetts have made the greatest gains in learning among all 50 states from 2000 onwards. As a result, we are placed here in the UAE to use this curriculum model in our context.

KG and Elementary Curriculum

Yas American Academy aspires to be a world-class school that challenges all of its students to achieve their highest potential and inspires them to be the critical thinkers, problem-solvers, artists, and innovators of the future who will make positive contributions to their communities, nations and the world.

Yas American Academy is an American Curriculum school located on Yas Island. The school is a part of Aldar Academies, one of the UAE's largest providers of leading private education, with schools in Abu Dhabi and Al Ain, rated outstanding by the Abu Dhabi Department of Education and Knowledge.

Yas American Academy is our first Massachusetts State Curriculum school in Abu Dhabi, which is the most highly regarded and successful public-school curriculum in the United States. The Massachusetts Curriculum draws on a rich history of academic excellence and rigor and has historically benefited from proximity to and interaction with higher education institutions such as Harvard University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

In Pre-KG we use The Creative Curriculum for Preschool which reflects the latest thinking in the field of early childhood education. It incorporates a number of elements that are of particular importance in providing comprehensive support for the whole child and expands support for teachers who work with English-Language Learners,

with examples of culturally and linguistically appropriate activities and materials and real-world strategies for engaging families from diverse backgrounds in their children's development and learning. The Creative Curriculum for Preschool is based on 38 objectives throughout the year for development and learning that focus on all the areas that are most important for school success: social-emotional, cognitive, math, literacy, physical, language, social studies, science and technology, and the arts. These objectives are built into every activity that happens in the classroom, enabling the Teacher to assist your child in building skills and knowledge in these important areas.

The US approach combines student-centered planning with interactive teaching methods to produce a broad and balanced education. At Yas American Academy, in addition to the MOE curriculum, our academic program is based on the Massachusetts Curriculum, which is a rigorous curriculum, based on common core standards. Yas American Academy delivers this curriculum through the Inquiry Approach to learning. Inquiry is an effective and dynamic process where students make connections across the subject groups of Physical Science, Social Science, History, Numeracy, Literacy, Arabic Dimension, The Arts and Physical Education, to know and understand the world. Inquiry allows the student to engage, think, create and be active in their learning and actions, providing opportunities for students to investigate, pose and solve problems, discover and test these discoveries.

The curriculum is supported by a robust emphasis on co-curricular and extra-curricular pursuits which helps foster well-rounded students. Yas American Academy offers AP (advanced placement) classes during the high school years, which are courses taught using university-level syllabi that can later be accredited to a degree program in US and Canadian universities (as per the liberal arts tradition). The curriculum will provide students with guidance and preparation for taking the SAT (the standardized examination required by US university admissions). Where appropriate, students can take our enhanced Arabic and Islamic Studies syllabi, preparing them for the unified Ministry of Education examinations.

Secondary Curriculum

Within our secondary school our curriculum combines student-centered planning with interactive teaching methods to produce a broad and balanced education. At Yas American Academy, in addition to the MOE curriculum, our academic program is based on the Massachusetts Curriculum, which is a rigorous curriculum, based on common core standards. The curriculum is supported by a robust emphasis on co-curricular and extra-curricular pursuits which helps foster well-rounded students. Yas American Academy offers AP (advanced placement) classes during the high school years, which are courses taught using university-level content that can later be accredited towards a degree program in US and other worldwide universities. In addition, our students are able to explore other interests outside of the core subjects including engineering, food technology, robotics, coding, performing arts, and many other amazing choices. Yas American Academy delivers this curriculum through the Inquiry Approach to Learning. Inquiry allows the student to engage, think, create and be active in their learning and actions, providing opportunities for students to investigate, pose and solve problems, discover, and test these discoveries.

The curriculum provides students with guidance and preparation for taking the SAT (the standardized examination required by US university admissions), EMSAT, IELTS and/or TOEFL. Within our curriculum we also have a strong emphasis towards ensuring students are connected to the UAE vision through encouraging culture, citizenship, and values to all. When students move into Grade 12 they have all of the skills and knowledge to be successful on the unified Ministry of Education examinations for Arabic and Islamic. Our graduates complete their journey and move on to start their university pathways in various countries around the world including some of the top ranked schools in the United Arab Emirates, United States of America, United Kingdom, Belgium, Canada, Australia, and many others. Overall, our secondary school has a focus of shaping our students to reach their full potential while allowing them the opportunity to learn and achieve in a holistic approach.

Pastoral Section

Children learn best when they feel safe and supported, and at Yas American Academy our House system helps to create a caring, welcoming environment where all students feel valued. Students are placed into one of four Houses representing the colours of the UAE flag: Emerald, Onyx, Diamond and Ruby. The accompanying Head of House and dedicated Homeroom teachers provide intensive daily support as they look to guide and nurture students through their academic and social experiences. The time and effort that is invested into each and every child promotes outstanding relationships between teachers and students, and helps further accelerate progress through a sense of family and belonging in the Academy.

Collaboration, Integrity, Respect, Innovation, and Determination are central characteristics to success.

Students are given opportunities to demonstrate the 'Yas American Way' through our very own Loyalty Card where they receive teacher signatures for positive behaviour. This will be issued on a termly basis and provides students with tangible rewards leading from certificates and positive phone calls home, all the way up to reward trips, lunch with the Principal and a movie afternoon.

The accompanying Head of House, Head of Department, Head of Grade and dedicated Homeroom teachers provide intensive daily support as they look to guide and nurture students through their academic and social experiences.
